
Emerging Issues

- Resource capacity to continue emergency planning, mitigation, and preparedness efforts statewide
- State match for federal disaster relief and state active duty
- Long-term disaster relief projects
- Disproportionate use of 9-1-1 taxes
- State share of deferred maintenance allocation






Oregon Military Department Expenditure History + 2021-23 Governor's Budget






Agency Budget by Expenditure Category (in millions)

Investments

- Resources and staffing to support mitigation planning and recovery efforts
- Appropriate revenue source to support core agency positions
- Other Funds expenditure limitation for the 9-1-1 program for the Public Safety Answering Points
- Expansion of the STARBASE Program at Camp Umatilla
- Ongoing Capital Construction projects
- Lottery Bond funding to support the SPIRE grants





Reductions

- Fund shifts from General Fund to Federal Funds and Other Funds where applicable
- Vacancy Savings up to five percent across all programs
- Inflationary savings across all fund types, less certain protected accounts
