**Measure Description:**

Eliminates minimum amount of fee added to judgment that includes monetary obligation that court or judicial branch is charged with collecting.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Judicial Department (OJD)

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:**

**Analysis:**

The measure eliminates the \$50 minimum fee courts are required to charge when a person establishes a payment plan with the court on a judgment with an outstanding financial obligation. The measure leaves in place the maximum \$200 fee for these filings and the discretion for Chief Justice of the Oregon Supreme Court to charge a fee that does exceed that amount. The Oregon Judicial department anticipates a minimal fiscal impact from these changes. Of note, is that a portion of this collection fee is by law deposited into the General Fund, if collected.
