SUBJECT: Marion County demographics and COVID-19 vaccines

Dear Chair, Vice-Chairs, and Members of the Subcommittee:

Thank you for the opportunity to present to the House Committee on Health Care Subcommittee on COVID-19 on March 10th, 2021.

According to the United States Census Bureau, individuals of Hispanic ethnicity account for 13% of Oregon's total population but only 3.5% of Oregon's population who are age 65+. In Marion County, persons of Hispanic ethnicity make up a quarter of the population, but an estimated 5% of Marion County's population age 65+ are of Hispanic ethnicity.

As of March 15th, 865,804 Oregonians have received a COVID-19 vaccine and of them, 4% reported their ethnicity as Hispanic.¹ Marion County is vaccinating people of Hispanic ethnicity at higher rates than the rest of the state. 7.6 of Marion County's Hispanic population has been vaccinated, compared to 6.9% of the rest of Oregon. Marion County is vaccinating people age 65+ and of Hispanic ethnicity at higher rates as well. 45.6% of Marion County's Hispanic population age 65+ have been vaccinated, compared to 35.4% of Oregon's Hispanic population age 65+.

¹ OHA uses a rarest race methodology when collecting individual data for COVID-19 vaccination. Individuals only contribute to one category: Native Hawaiian, Pacific Islander; Black, African American; American Indian, Alaska Native; Asian; Hispanic; White; Other; or Unknown. The count of people of Hispanic ethnicity who have been vaccinated is estimated to be slightly lower if individuals who are Hispanic selected another category for race/ethnicity.
