Measure Description:

Permits adopted former foster children to have amount of tuition and all fees waived if attending defined institutions of higher education for purposes of pursuing initial undergraduate degree.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC), Public Universities, Community Colleges

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure permits adopted former foster children to have the amount of tuition and all fees waived if attending defined institutions of higher education.
