Measure Description:

Directs Department of Education to conduct study on instruction provided to talented and gifted children and to report results of study to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to education.

Analysis: This measure directs Department of Education (ODE) to conduct study on instruction provided to talented and gifted children and to report results of study to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to education no later than September 15, 2022.

Due to the timeframe required by the measure, ODE will require one Research Analyst 4 (0.50 FTE) Limited Duration position. This person will need to travel to the school districts in order to observe instruction, hold outreach meetings and gather sufficient samplings in order to produce the report.

This measure warrants a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means for consideration of its budgetary impact on the State’s General Fund.
