WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Appropriates unspecified amount of money from the General Fund to the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department to complete development of the Oregon Coast Trail for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-1 Replaces the measure. Appropriates unspecified amount of money from the General Fund to the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) to continue to develop the Oregon Coast Trail for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021. Directs OPRD to allocate not more than \$1 million of lottery funding designated for outdoor recreation improvement projects to qualifying projects to develop, maintain or work toward completion of the Oregon Coast Trail.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued

BACKGROUND:

The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department oversees the designation process and management of the scenic bikeways, scenic waterways, and scenic and recreational trail programs. The Oregon Coast Trail consists of ten trail segments that run the length of Oregon's 363-mile coastline.

House Bill 3281 would appropriate moneys to the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department to complete development of the Oregon Coast Trail.
