WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires the range of user fees adopted by the State Parks and Recreation Commission for use of recreational vehicles at areas established and maintained by the State Parks and Recreation Department to be 25 percent greater for non-residents than for residents. Takes effect 91st day following adjournment sine die.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Oregon State Parks and Recreation Commission sets rates for the use of park facilities. The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) collects user fees for overnight and day use facilities, and reservations.

Senate Bill 794 would require the Commission to set fees 25 percent higher for non-residents than for residents for use of recreational vehicles at areas established and maintained by OPRD.
