

## **HB 3013 -1, -2 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY**

#### **WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Directs the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to study cannabis regulation in the state. Requires commission to submit a report to the Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2021. Sunsets provisions January 2, 2022. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

#### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

##### **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

-1 Directs the Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC) to establish by rule a process to register medical marijuana processing sites and medical marijuana dispensaries. Sets requirements for transfer and receipt of medical cannabinoid products, including tracking. Establishes requirements for proximity of dispensaries to schools. Authorizes the OLCC to adopt rules and impose civil penalties. Allows medical marijuana processing sites and medical marijuana dispensaries to apply for OLCC registration beginning October 1, 2021. Prohibits the Oregon Health Authority from issuing or renewing marijuana processing or marijuana dispensary registrations on or after October 1, 2021. Takes effect 91<sup>st</sup> day following adjournment sine die.

-2 Replaces the measure. Directs OLCC to adopt rules authorizing licensed marijuana producer to receive marijuana seeds from any source in this state.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

House Bill 3013 directs the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to study cannabis regulation in the state and submit a report to the Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2021, and sunsets these provisions January 2, 2022.
