

HB 3307 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Authorizes intergovernmental entity created by written agreement to seek to obtain benefits from any public or private entity that a local government or American Indian Tribe, as a party to the same agreement, may also seek to obtain. Requires benefits sought be solely for the purposes for which the intergovernmental entity was created. Declares emergency, effective upon passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

ORS 190.003 to 190.130 relate to intergovernmental cooperation and define terms, requirements of agreements, and other specifications for work between government entities. Examples of agreement requirements include clarifying responsibility for providing funds to pay for expenses incurred in the performance of the functions or activities, accounting for the apportionment of fees or other revenue derived from the functions or activities in the agreement, and the transfer of any personnel and the preservation of their employment benefits.

Additionally, any intergovernmental agreement must provide for the term or duration of the agreement, which may be perpetual, and the rights of the parties to terminate the agreement.

House Bill 3307 authorizes an intergovernmental entity created by written agreement to seek to obtain benefits from any public or private entity that a local government or American Indian Tribe, as a party to the same agreement, may also seek to obtain. The measure requires that the benefits sought be solely for the purposes for which the intergovernmental entity was created.
