WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Extends privilege taxes on merchantable forest products harvested on forestlands. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Currently, the Forest Products Harvest tax is a combined tax rate, made of the following elements. For each thousand board feet, board measure:

\$4.1322 - Total Tax Rate per MBF (2020)

\$0.9000 - Forest resource research

\$0.6250 - Oregon Forestland Protection Fund

\$1.3872 - Forest Practices Act

\$0.1000 – Forestry Education

\$1.1200 - for Oregon Forest Resources Institute

The first 25,000 board feet harvest annually are exempt for any tax filer.
