WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires school districts to provide at least 15 minutes of instruction per school year on organ and tissue donation beginning with the 2022-2023 school year. Allows Oregon Department of Education to provide technical assistance. Takes effect July 1, 2022.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-2 Replaces the measure. Requires each school district to provide instruction on organ and tissue donation beginning in the 2025-2026 school year. Requires State Board of Education to adopt related health education content standards by September 1, 2024.

FISCAL: Has minimal fiscal impact

REVENUE: No revenue impact

BACKGROUND:

The health content standards currently in place for Oregon's K-12 schools do not cover the issue of organ and tissue donation. House Bill 3234 -2 requires school districts to provide instruction related to organ and tissue donation beginning with the 2025-2026 school year and requires the State Board of Education to adopt related content standards.
