- Recognize Structure and Functions of Government





New Additions - Expanding Democracy

 Analyze the positive and negative implications of the (federal laws and actions) for political, legal, economic, and social equality for all, including traditionally marginalized groups.

 Identify, discuss, and explain the exclusionary language and intent of the Oregon and U.S. Constitution and the provisions and process for the expansion and protection of civil rights.

 Analyze and evaluate the methods for challenging, resisting, and changing society in the promotion of equity, justice and equality.
