<u>Category Descriptions:</u>	
Core County/CMHP Functions	Services provided directly by the County/CMHP through contract with direct oversight. These services have legal implications or other factors regarding coordination or rights that make the county-based CMHP the best administrator. <i>Responsible for assuring safety net and must be funded equitably statewide.</i>
Other Programs and Services	Behavioral health services provided by choice. CMHP can provide the services (often as the provider of last resort as there are no other providers available) or the services are provided by private agencies/providers with some element of contractual/performance monitoring. These services have fidelity standards and the County/CMHP or private agency are certified by the State to provide (ideally with the County/CMHP working as an agent of the State to monitor performance) <i>Subject to the availability of funds</i>
Unclear	Not clear who has the role or there is duplication among system partners, leading to confusion in the system
