

Oregon Long Term Care Licensed Facilities with Confirmed COVID-19 Cases

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Facilities may limit indoor visitation in some cases, which are:

- If an Executive Order restricting visitation is in effect.
- If the resident to be visited has not had a COVID-19 vaccine and the following additional conditions exist:
 - The facility is in a county with a COVID-19 positivity rate of >10%.
 - <70% of residents in the facility are fully vaccinated.
- The resident to be visited has a confirmed COVID-19 infection (it does not matter if they have been vaccinated) and they have not yet met the criteria to discontinue transmission-based precautions.
- If the resident to be visited is in quarantine (it does not matter if they have been vaccinated).
- If the visitor will not adhere to infection prevention guidance.
