Subject: SB 226 – Relating to Education

Work Session Recommendations

This measure with the proposed amendment authorizes the transfer of \$200.0 million from the Education Stability Fund (ESF) to the State School Fund for spending during 2021-23. The combination of this transfer when combined with General Fund, Lottery Funds, Fund for Student Success, and other resources will provide \$9.3 billion for the State School Fund.

This measure as amended with require a three-fifths vote in each of the legislative chambers to pass.

A preliminary staff measure summary and fiscal impact statement are available on OLIS. A revenue impact statement is being prepared for the measure.
