HB 5021 Medical Board

HB 5021 is the budget bill for the Oregon Medical Board.

The Medical Board licenses Medical and osteopathic doctors, podiatric physicians, physician assistants, and acupuncturists; investigates complaints against licensees and takes disciplinary action when a violation occurs. The Board is also responsible for the scope of practice for first responders and emergency medical technicians.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends a budget of \$17,036,386 Other Funds and 42 positions (42.00 FTE). This is a 12.7% increase over the 2021-23 current service level.

The budget adds one-time funding of \$1.6 million for core business software modernization, one-time funding of \$72,000 for an information security management upgrade, and one full-time Investigator position to meet the needs of the rising medical investigation workload.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 5021 be amended by the -1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
