# WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Allows Board of Medical Imaging to issue subpoena over signature of board executive director when conducting investigation. Takes effect 91st day following adjournment sine die.

Senate Vote: Passed. Ayes, 26; Nays, 4 (Boquist, Heard, Linthicum, Thomsen)

REVENUE: No revenue impact

FISCAL: Has minimal fiscal impact

#### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

• Subject of Board-issued subpoenas

## **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The Oregon Board of Medical Imaging (OBMI) licenses and regulates radiographers, radiation therapists, limited X-ray machine operators, nuclear medicine technologists, sonographers, MRI technologists, and Bone Densitometry. Currently, OBMI's authority to issue subpoenas is limited to requiring the signature of the board chairperson.

Senate Bill 100 allows the Board of Medical Imaging to issue subpoenas over the signature of the board executive director in addition to the board chairperson.
