WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Adds certified speech-language pathology assistant to membership of State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology (Board). Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

• Value of adding speech-language pathology assistant perspective to Board

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Oregon State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology (Board) was established in 1973 to regulate the performance of audiologists, speech-language pathologists, and speech-language pathology assistants. The Board is currently comprised of seven members: two audiologists, two speech-language pathologists, two members of the public, and an Otolaryngologist.

Senate Bill 124 adds a certified speech-language pathology assistant to membership of the State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology.
