Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Special Committee on Wildfire Recovery to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs distributions from lottery bond proceeds and the state General Fund in order to address identified wildfire recovery needs across the state. Total funding included in this measure totals \$916.9 million.
