Subject: SB 5522 – Relating to the financial administration of the Board of Medical Imaging. Work Session Recommendations

ORS 291.055(1)(e) stipulates that all new state agency fees or fee increases adopted between the date of adjournment sine die of a regular session of the Legislative Assembly and the date of adjournment sine die of the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly, are rescinded upon adjournment sine die of the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly unless the fee is authorized by enabling legislation.

SB 5522 provides the enabling legislation necessary to approve fees adopted through administrative rule by the Oregon Board of Medical Imaging (OBMI) during the 2020-21 Interim. Fees were adjusted for temporary licenses, temporary limited permits, permanent licenses, permanent permits, and fluoroscopy permits. These fee modifications are anticipated to generate \$581,760 Other Funds revenue during the 2021-23 biennium. The 2021-23 Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) Recommended Budget for the Oregon Board of Medical Imaging (OBMI) assumes the continuation of the revenue from the fee increases included in this measure.
