Propose state goals for carbon sequestration and storage by Oregon's natural and working landscapes, including agriculture, based on best available science by June 30, 2021

- Create a sustained source of funding for research on climate mitigation strategies on Oregon's agricultural lands
- Adopt Healthy Soils legislation to create a Soil Health Grant Program for farmers

#### **OrCAN's Policy Recommendations**

Facilitate multi-stakeholder collaboration both public and private, to advance these recommendations. Ensure the inclusion of BIPOC farmers in decision-making in program development and implementation, including access to any funding.


