


Wildfire Debris & Hazard Tree Removal Update


HOUSE SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON WILDFIRE RECOVERY





Weekly topline points | from the week of May 24-28

- We have passed the halfway point for participating home sites cleared. +87 cleared sites completed this week for a total of 1,966 statewide (out of 2,831 total home sites).
- 80,604 fire-damaged trees marked and 39,098 removed of the more than 140,000 estimated statewide. Trees are marked through a series of reviews and quality control measures.
- Review of hazard tree operation underway by an Independent arborist. Field work
 completed with final report expected in early June and we look forward to learning more
 about any potential recommendations.
- **Know before you go this Memorial Day.** Along with TripCheck, add Oregon's <u>recreation</u> <u>site status map</u> to your resource list. It's a must-check, one-stop shop for anyone exploring the outdoors this summer.
- The deadline to apply for property cleanup is approaching. We want to give everyone with wildfire damaged properties the opportunity to participate in the state-led cleanup program.

Debris Cleanup




As of Thursday 5/27/21
