

## **HB 3367 -2 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY**

### **House Special Committee On Wildfire Recovery**

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#### **WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Requires local governments to unconditionally allow restoration or replacement of certain uses destroyed by 2020 wildfires until December 31, 2025. Sunsets January 2, 2026. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

*REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued*

*FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued*

#### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

##### **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

-2 Establishes the Lost Revenue Stabilization Fund in the State Treasury and authorizes moneys to be continually appropriated to the Department of Revenue for disbursements to local governments and nonprofit organizations for reimbursement of lost revenue related to the 2020 wildfires. Establishes the School Stabilization Fund in the State Treasury and authorizes moneys to be continually appropriated to the Department of Education for disbursements to fire-impacted school districts to assist with costs related to the 2020 wildfires. Sunsets June 30, 2027. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

*REVENUE: No revenue impact.*

*FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued*

##### **BACKGROUND:**

House Bill 3367 would require local governments to unconditionally allow restoration or replacement of certain uses destroyed by 2020 wildfires until December 31, 2025.
