Measure Description:

Funds wildfire recovery projects across the state.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Special Committee on Wildfire Recovery to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs distributions from lottery bond proceeds, the state highway fund, and the General Fund in order to address identified wildfire recovery needs across the state. Funding included in this measure totals \$919.7 million.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
