Subject:	HB 2378 – Relating to competency-based education Work Session Recommendations

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to establish pilot program for competency-based education. Requires that pilot program issue grants to public post-secondary institutions of higher education to fund promotion, expansion, and implementation of competency-based education programs. Allows HECC to adopt rules necessary to administer pilot program and issue grants. Sunsets January 2, 2024. Appropriates \$200,000 General Fund to Higher Education Coordinating Commission from General Fund to fund pilot program. Modifies requirement for HECC to annually report on competency-based education to add requirement to analyze student outcomes and identify additional funding strategies. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.
