Subject: HB 2007 - Relating to addressing disparities. Work Session Recommendations

HB 2007 Establishes the 16-member Joint Task Force on Addressing Racial Disparities in Home Ownership charged with reviewing the reports and continuing the work of the Task Force on Addressing Racial Disparities in Home Ownership and recommending legislative solutions to eliminating barriers for homeownership for people of color in Oregon. Members of the Joint Task Force are entitled to compensation through LPRO. The Joint Task Force is required to report to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly by September 15, 2022. The Joint Task Force sunsets on December 31, 2022.

The fiscal impact of this measure is anticipated to be minimal.

The measure previously had a hearing in the House Committee on Housing on 3/30/2021 and 4/8/2021 and was reported out with a do pass recommendation.

## Recommended Changes

The -A2 amendment removes the $\$ 1$ General Fund appropriation. LFO recommends adoption of the -A2 amendment.

## Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that HB 2007, as amended by the -A2 amendment, be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
