Subject: SB 300 - Relating to towing

**Work Session Recommendations** 

The measure establishes the State Board of Towing within the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT). The Board will have the authority to direct ODOT to deny, suspend, revoke or refuse to renew a towing business certificate; as well as direct the Oregon State Police to remove a tower from the tow rotation list. In addition, the measure allows the Board to impose a fee on any person holding or applying for a towing business certificate.
