Subject:	SB 497A – Relating to designated person misdemeanors Work Session Recommendations

SB 497A requires counties to assume responsibility for community-based supervision, sanctions, and services for designated domestic violence misdemeanors. The bill requires the court to ensure that when a person is convicted of certain crimes involving domestic violence, the judgment document reflects that the conviction qualifies as a designated person misdemeanor as defined by the measure. Additionally, the bill states that a person convicted of certain designated person misdemeanors qualifies for earned reductions to the term of probation.

#### **Recommended Changes**

LFO recommends adoption of the -A3 amendment, which provides \$7,060,171 General Fund to the Department of Corrections to pass through to counties for costs associated with the supervision of those convicted of designated person misdemeanors.

#### **Final Subcommittee Action**

LFO recommends that SB 497, as amended by the -A3 amendment, to be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
