**Subject:** SB 38 – Relating to tall structure evaluation fee  
Work Session Recommendations

The Department of Aviation (ODA) is required to evaluate tall structures that have the potential to penetrate safety of flight airspace around airports to determine if these structures constitute hazards. ODA does not currently charge for this evaluation. SB 38 allows ODA to establish a fee for tall structure evaluation.

ODA anticipates establishing a fee of \$100 per application to recover costs of the evaluation. ODA estimates it will conduct 1,845 evaluations in 2022 and 2,704 in the 2023-25 biennium.

### Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that SB 38 be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
