Subject: HB2740 – Relating to Retail Sales Agents
Work Session Recommendations

HB 2740 sets in statute a compensation formula to be paid by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission. The formula establishes 10 classes of stores based on sales, increases base compensation over what was paid in the current biennium, and factors in store location and escalators tied to the Consumer Price Index and minimum wage.

The new formula is estimated to increase the compensation paid to liquor retail agents by \$13.5 million in total in the 2021-23, and is reflected in Policy Option Package 108 in HB 5018, the agency's budget bill.
