

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 3353

Relating to health care expenditures

HB 3353 directs the Oregon Health Authority to seek approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to require coordinated care organizations to spend up to 3% of their global budgets to improve health equity; address social determinants of health; diversify care locations; and improve overall community health. Upon CMS approval, CCOs are required to spend a minimum of 3% of their global budgets on these services and OHA must convene an oversight committee to evaluate the new CCO expenditures and recommend best practices for the investments. The measure has a minimal fiscal impact.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 3353 be amended by the -A5 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
