Subject: HB 3294 – Relating to feminine hygiene products in public schools
Work Session Recommendations

The measure requires school districts, charter schools, Education Service Districts (ESDs), community colleges, and public universities to stock menstrual products in two student bathrooms in each facility for the first year of the biennium and every bathroom in the second year. The Other Funds in this program are a distribution or carve-out from the State School Fund (SSF) and identified as Grants-in-Aid for the Oregon Department of Education. The measure has a blank amount for the distribution from the SSF. This fiscal assumes that the State School Fund is not increased to cover the amount of the distribution.

The -A4 amendment transfers \$5,595,000 from the State School Fund to be used for Grant-in-Aids and appropriates \$137,483 General Fund to the Department of Education to administer the program.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A4 amendment.

Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that HB 3294, as amended by the -A4 amendment, to be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
