SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 2591 Relating to school-based health center grants

To: Ways and Means Full Committee From: Human Services Subcommittee

HB 2591 directs the Oregon Health Authority to create a grant program related to health care in schools. OHA will provide planning grants to ten school and education service districts to evaluate the need for school-based health services in their communities. After the two-year planning process, each grantee will receive funding to operate a school-based health center or school nurse model in their district. The measure includes a \$2,555,000 General Fund appropriation in 2021-23 for the program.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 2591 be reported out do pass.
