HB 2932 – Relating to the use of physical force Subject:

**Work Session Recommendations** 

HB 2932 directs law enforcement units, as defined by ORS 181A.355, to participate in the National Use-of-Force Data Collection operated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), and directs the Criminal Justice Commission to analyze data from that database and report to the Legislature annually with the analysis.

## **Recommended Changes**

LFO recommends adoption of the -A13 amendment, which provides \$198,996 General Fund to the Criminal Justice Commission to implement the provisions of the bill; and which provides \$260,574 General Fund to the Department of Corrections, to support one position (1.00 FTE) to gather use of force data and report to the FBI as required by the measure.

## **Final Subcommittee Action**

LFO recommends that HB 2932, as amended by the -A13 amendment, to be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
