WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Eliminates provision providing for automatic imposition of monthly supervision fees for supervision by community corrections program.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-2 Replaces measure. Repeals authority of community corrections program, State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision, or other local supervisory authority, to impose or collect a monthly fee to offset costs of supervising a individual's probation, parole, post-prison supervision or other supervised release. Removes court authority to impose or collect fees for court ordered supervision or violations of court ordered supervision. Prohibits the State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision from requiring a supervised person to pay a fee to the victim impact program to offset the cost of the person's participation in the program.

BACKGROUND:

Currently, under Oregon law, a person sentenced to probation or placed by an authority on parole, post-prison supervision, or other form of release, subject to supervision by a community corrections program, is required to pay a monthly fee to offset costs of supervising the probation, parole, post-prison supervision, or other supervised release. See ORS 423.570. Timely payment of the fee is made a condition of such probation, parole, post-prison supervision or other supervised release.

Senate Bill 620 eliminates the automatic imposition of supervision fees as a condition of probationary sentence or supervision.
