

## **SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION**

### **SB 65**

#### **Relating to health insurance**

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To: Ways and Means Full Committee  
From: Human Services Subcommittee  
Carrier: Senator Lieber

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SB 65 transfers the Compact of Free Association, or COFA, Premium Assistance Program and the health insurance exchange from the Department of Consumer and Business Services to the Oregon Health Authority. The transfer includes records, properties, employees, and available funds.

OHA is directed to report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health on the progress of this transfer by September 15, 2022, with annual reports required through 2025. Should this measure pass, the transfer of funding and positions from DCBS to OHA will be included in the end of session bill.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends SB 65 be reported out do pass.
