SB 575 creates a procedure for the automatic expunction of certain types of juvenile records. It provides for court-appointed counsel for financially eligible applicants in the beginning of the process. The automatic expungement process only applies to youth who reach the age of 18 and have been referred to but were never adjudicated in juvenile court. The bill requires that certain conditions apply to a person for whom a county juvenile department applies for expunction. This bill has a fiscal impact that will be addressed in the omnibus budget measure at the end of session.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends SB 575 be reported out do pass.
