Subject: HB 2930 – Relating to standards concerning law enforcement officer conduct

Work Session Recommendations

House Bill 2930 A removes the discipline matrix or discipline guide as a mandatory subject of collective bargaining for law enforcement, establishes the Commission on Statewide Law Enforcement Standards of Conduct and Discipline, and creates conditions for arbitrators. Provisions of the measure apply to collective bargaining agreements entered into after the effective date of the act.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -18 amendment, which adds citizen oversight or advisory boards wherever a law enforcement agency is referenced, adjusts language regarding use of force and moral character, and makes changes to effective dates.

LFO also recommends adoption of the -20 amendment, which adds \$255,733 General Fund to the Department of State Police to pay for the cost of training sworn officers based on the new standards.

Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that HB 2930, as amended by the -A18 and -A20 amendments, be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
