SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 2930

Relating to standards concerning law enforcement officer conduct

HB 2930 removes the discipline matrix or discipline guide as a mandatory subject of collective bargaining for law enforcement. It establishes the Commission on Statewide Law Enforcement Standards of Conduct and Discipline, and creates conditions for arbitrators. Provisions of the measure apply to collective bargaining agreements entered into after the effective date of the act.

The recommended amendment adds citizen oversight or advisory boards wherever a law enforcement agency is referenced, adjusts language regarding use of force and moral character, and appropriates \$255,733 General Fund to the Department of State Police to pay for training sworn officers on the new standards.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends HB 2930 be amended by the –A22 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
