

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 358

Relating to applied behavior analysis

To: Ways and Means Full Committee

Carrier: Senator Lieber

SB 358 extends the sunset on the requirement that health insurers cover applied behavior analysis services for autism spectrum disorders from January 2, 2022 to January 2, 2030.

If the sunset were to remain in place, the Oregon Health Authority estimates a small savings would occur from reduced public employee health care payments for these services. The measure otherwise does not have a budgetary impact.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends SB 358 be amended by the -A2 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
