

CONFLICT AMENDMENT RECOMMENDATION

SB 755

Relating to substance use

To: Ways and Means Full Committee

SB 755 amends the Drug Addiction Treatment and Recovery Act, which was enacted through the approval of Ballot Measure 110 during the November 2020 general election. The Joint Committee on Ways and Means previously approved this bill, and it has passed the Senate.

The -B38 amendment resolves conflicts with SB 497, which was also previously approved by this committee and impacts one of the same sections of law as SB 755. The amendment requires community-based supervision for designated person misdemeanors involving domestic violence and appropriates \$7 million General Fund to the Department of Corrections to support this work. These provisions also exist in SB 497 and will be repealed in that bill if it passes.

I recommend SB 755 be amended by the -B38 conflict amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
