

CONFLICT AMENDMENT RECOMMENDATION

HB 2740

Relating to retail sales agents

HB2740 sets in statute a compensation formula to be paid by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission. The formula establishes 10 classes of stores based on sales, increases base compensation over what was paid in the current biennium, and factors in store location and escalators tied to the Consumer Price Index and minimum wage.

The Joint Committee on Ways and Means previously approved this bill, and it has passed the House.

The –1 amendment resolves conflicts with HB 2264. It references the new compensation formula in HB 2264, which allows OLCC to negotiate price with tribes and commercial airlines for the sale of distilled liquor.

I recommend HB 2740 be amended by the –1 conflict amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
