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SUMMARY

Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish and operate statewide registry for collection and dissemination of advance directives. Establishes Oregon Advance Directive Registry Advisory Committee to advise authority regarding registry.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure records collected or developed by the Oregon Health Authority in administering an advance directive registry that identifies or could identify a patient, health care provider or facility.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive patients' advance directives and information related to the health care providers and facilities that collect and receive patients' advance directives.
