SUMMARY

Maintains indefinitely exemption from required disclosure of public records that are subject to lawyer-client privilege and public records exemption for privileged information.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure maintains indefinitely the exemption from public disclosure of records that are subject to lawyer-client privilege.

If those public records were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive information related to legal work performed on behalf of public bodies.
