SUMMARY

Modifies provisions relating to public records about public safety officers.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure removes the exemptions from public disclosure of records related to personnel investigations of public safety employees, audio and video records of internal investigation interviews of public safety officers and records regarding personnel discipline actions against certified reserve officers, corrections officers, parole and probation officers, police officers and youth correction officers.

This measure subjects those public records to mandatory disclosure under public records law, unless another exemption from public disclosure applies.
