SUMMARY

Removes requirement that physician assistant practice under supervising physician. Requires physician assistant to enter into collaboration agreement with physician, podiatric physician or clinically experienced physician assistant. Defines "collaboration agreement." Makes permanent ability of physician assistant to use telehealth to provide care for patient located in another state.

Becomes operative January 1, 2022.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.
