#### WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Oregon Department of Education to provide technical assistance to school districts in developing and implementing the sexual abuse prevention instructional program required by ORS 336.059.

#### ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Implementation of ORS 336.059

#### EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

#### BACKGROUND:

The requirement that school districts adopt child sex abuse prevention instructional programs was established by the legislature in Senate Bill 856 (2015). House Bill 2828 adds a requirement that the Oregon Department of Education provide districts with relevant technical assistance.
