SUMMARY

Exempts from disclosure as public record personally identifiable information about child under age of 16 years that is submitted to State Fish and Wildlife Commission or agent of commission to obtain license, tag or permit under wildlife laws.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure personally identifiable information of children under the age of 16 years that is submitted to the State Fish and Wildlife Commission or an agent of the commission to obtain a license, tag or permit under wildlife laws.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive personally identifiable information of children under the age of 16 years requesting a license, tag or permit under wildlife laws.
