**Measure Description:**

Directs Office of Emergency Management to develop and administer grant program in support of projects to consolidate and modernize or upgrade public safety answering points.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Military Department (OMD)

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:**

**Analysis:**

HB 2425 establishes the Public Safety Answer Point Consolidation Fund and directs the Office of Emergency Management (OEM) to develop and administer a grant program for projects to consolidate and modernize public safety answering points. Under this measure OEM may approve two such projects per biennium.

In addition to the amount that may be appropriated to capitalize the Public Safety Answer Point Consolidation Fund, OMD anticipates an indeterminate fiscal impact from this measure, and may need to hire a Program Analyst 3 to oversee the fund.

This measure requires budgetary action for the allocation of General Fund resources and position establishment.
