WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Revises statutes to maintain accuracy. Corrects punctuation and grammatical errors. Conforms language to legislative form and style. Removes obsolete references, standardizes terminology, and removes statutes from inappropriate series. Corrects citation to federal law. Makes other nonsubstantive corrections.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Duty of the Office of Legislative Counsel to prepare a reviser's bill each long session
- Intended to be nonsubstantive changes
- Stylistic changes
- Citation corrections

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

Removes reference to ORS 442.325. Removes Section 55.

BACKGROUND:

In every long session, the Office of Legislative Counsel Introduces a "reviser's bill" to make nonsubstantive, corrective, and technical changes to Oregon law.

House Bill 3104 is this session's reviser's bill.
